Sanctions to Skate Overseas

- Skaters, coaches and parents are reminded that Sanctions to Skate Overseas must be applied for prior to the closing of entries for any overseas event.
- Sanctions will only be issued for the current skating year [ie through to 30 June in any year that the skater is federated with NZFRS].
- Skaters proceeding overseas for training and/or development should give us much notice for a sanction as possible.
- Retrospective sanctions will not be issued.
