The Oceania Confederation of Roller Sports advises that the 2016 Oceania Speed Skating Championships will be hosted by the New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports [Skate NZ] in Timaru, New Zealand.

The Championships are open to skaters from countries affiliated to FIRS. Federation sanctions from home federations will be required for international skaters.
