Introduction	Good participation and continuity within committee, skater retention ok, friendly environment in club. We have this year updated our club constitution and are currently underway with preparing a 5 year Strategic Plan. High floor charges (and therefore funding requirement) and outages are an ongoing issue with the stadium, but manageable.
Skating Numbers and Growth	Total Club Registrations: 164 (cf 168 2016) members comprising 36 club skaters, 11 Coach/Associate, 117 Learn to Skate. Our biggest challenge continues to be recruiting skaters from Learn to Skate through to club level and into competitions.
Skaters / Senior Skaters involvement (Coaching, judging, mentoring etc)	<p>Club Coaches are Leanne Raffles, Andrew Rae, Madison Collis, Emily Clague, Laura Strangward, plus Macarena Carrascosa, Rachael Parkinson Turner and Hannah Calderon as visiting coaches. Ongoing mentoring by Leanne and development of past and present skaters with coaching accreditation and four assistant LTS coaches completing their training for certification. Our two most senior skaters (Madi senior & Emily junior) still volunteer coach at LTS classes which is outstanding after 7 years continuous service!</p> <p>Our international judge Jane Reason has mentored Sarah Reason and Sarah Mays through to gaining Level 4 accreditation, plus Samantha Reason as Level 3 judge, and now with her Level 2 Figures Judges Commission.</p>
Competitors competing at Oceanias / Worlds	Once again we have 4 skaters qualified to compete at Oceanias in Brisbane 21-24 Sept 2017; Andrew Rae, Madison Collis, Emily Clague and Lisa Garrud. We have had no skaters competing at Worlds for several years.
Public Sessions	SAME – nil. Reduced opportunity due to high floor cost and probably not enough skates (looking to buy more).
Community Involvement	Promote artistic roller skating where possible to the West Auckland community and visibility and awareness of being at Trusts Arena is helpful. Initiatives by Madi and Leanne working with Youthtown and OnBoard Skate with school holiday programmes.
Life Members	Added to our constitution January 2016 and unanimous vote at AGM that first life membership be awarded to Jane Reason for her outstanding service to the club.
