## **Purpose:**

The Board and members of the New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports (Inc) are committed to providing to the competitors, officials, volunteers and supporters a safe and healthy sports environment.

## **Procedures:**

During the events all members of the New Zealand Federation of Roller Sports (Inc) will put in place processes to eliminate, isolate and minimise any potential sports specific hazards to ensure no one is harmed. These processes include:

- The NZFRS will comply with The Health and Safety at Work Act 2015
- The Venue's (Venue where event is being held) Health & Safety policy will be adopted.
- Both venue and sports specific hazards will be identified so that all attending the event can be safe-guarded.
- Procedures for accidents and emergency situations are included in the Championship Managers Pack in relation to that event, in the programme and will be discussed at the Team Managers meetings.
- The NZFRS will retain an accident and incident register
- An Event Health & Safety Plan including risk assessments to be completed for each Championship.
- All supporting documentation will be sent to the NZFRS Secretary
