The Oceania Confederation of Roller Sports advises that the 2017 Oceania Speed Skating Championships will be hosted by Skate Australia Inc in Brisbane, Australia. The competition venue is located 5 minutes from Brisbane International & Domestic Airport in the northern Brisbane suburb of Nundah.

The Championships are open to skaters from countries affiliated to FIRS. Federation sanctions from home federations will be required for international skaters.
