Policy Making

MAKING POLICIES

PURPOSE:

To ensure that a clear process exists for development and implementing Policy. That the Policy making process is available to all members of the NZ Federation of Roller Sports.

PROCEDURES:

1. The Board will make all final NZFRS policy decisions.
2. There shall always be a concern for the legality and consistency of all proposed policies. Policies shall be compatible and in accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws of the Federation & Sports Committees.
3. All policy making will be channeled through the Board's policy making process which is as follows:-
 - a) The Board, Sports Committees, Member Clubs and Individual Members may initiate policy Development.
 - b) The Board will oversee proposals put to the Board for the development of any policy and may suggest various parties who might be consulted or involved in the process. These might include members of the Federation, Sports Committees, Member Clubs, other community members or invited specialists in that area of policy making.
 - c) The draft policy or selection of policies is brought back to the Board for discussion and/or approval.
 - d) The Board approves, amends or rejects the policy/s
4. All policies are subject to bi annual review by the Board.
