

N . Z . F . R . S REGISTRATIONS

OBJECTIVES:

To provide guidelines for the administration of NZFRS membership.

PROCEDURES:

1. The financial year and membership registration year of the NZFRS will be from July 1 to June 30 each year (By Law 5.04.01)
2. New Registrations and Re-registrations must be received by the National Office on the attached Registration Form through a Member Club.
3. All coaches and officials are required to register by 1 July each year by completing the attached form.
4. Subject to the provisions of Bylaw 6.02.02 persons who participate in NZFRS member Club activities must hold a current NZFRS membership registration card. (By Law 6.02.01)
5. Membership and affiliation fees will be determined by the NZFRS Annual General Meeting on recommendation of the Board. This fee will be payable by 1 JULY each year. Any member not paying such subscription within 30 days after this date shall cease to be a member. (By Law 6.02.03)
6. There will be seven (7) classes of Membership Registration: (By Law 6.03.01)

i) CLASS 1	Competitive Skater	May participate in all events including NZFRS events.
ii) CLASS 2	Competitive Skater	May participate only in Club events, Leagues, Achievement Tests, excluding NZFRS events.
iii) Class 3	Non Competitive Club Skater	Recreational skaters at Club level
iv) CLASS 4a	Registered Officials	This class of membership includes officials who are qualified to officiate at NZFRS events or who are members of NZFRS Committees. This includes Team Officials
v) Class 4b	Registered Coaches	This class of membership includes Coaches who are registered with the NZFRS
vi) CLASS 5	Club Officials & Supporters	This class of membership includes officials who only undertake their duties within their own member club, members of club committees and supporters of the sport and participants in Club Show Challenge only
vii) CLASS 6	Club Affiliation	Incorporated Clubs
viii) CLASS 7	Corporate	Companies, Organisations supporting the sport.
Family Membership		Membership includes 2 parents and up children up to and including 18 years of age. Any class of competitive skater membership applies. Each member must complete a membership application form stating Class as above.
Affiliates		National Governing Bodies affiliated to NZFRS, with or without voting rights.

7. An NZFRS event is defined as a competition from Regional to National level. (By Law 6.03.02)

8. Individual registration membership (i.e. Class 1, Class 2, Class 3, Class 4 and Class 5) must be affiliated to a member club of NZFRS. (By Law 6.03.03)
9. Club Representatives to NZFRS Annual or Special General Meetings must have either CLASS 1, 4 or 5 membership registration in order to exercise their vote. (6.03.04)
10. The NZFRS reserves the right to repossess the registration card from a competitor or official and exclude him/her from participation for a certain period for breach of the general intent of these By-Laws upon evidence which the NZFRS considers adequate after affording the registered member concerned an opportunity to render an explanation (if desired in writing). If the registered member does not avail himself/herself of such an opportunity within the given time his/her right to furnish an explanation is forfeited. (By Law 6.03.05)
11. National Office to advise individual Sports Committees of all Registrations pertaining to their specific discipline.
